Think about the “Stay at Home” orders we currently have. How does this compare with traveling with all your things to a far land, and being short of food and water?

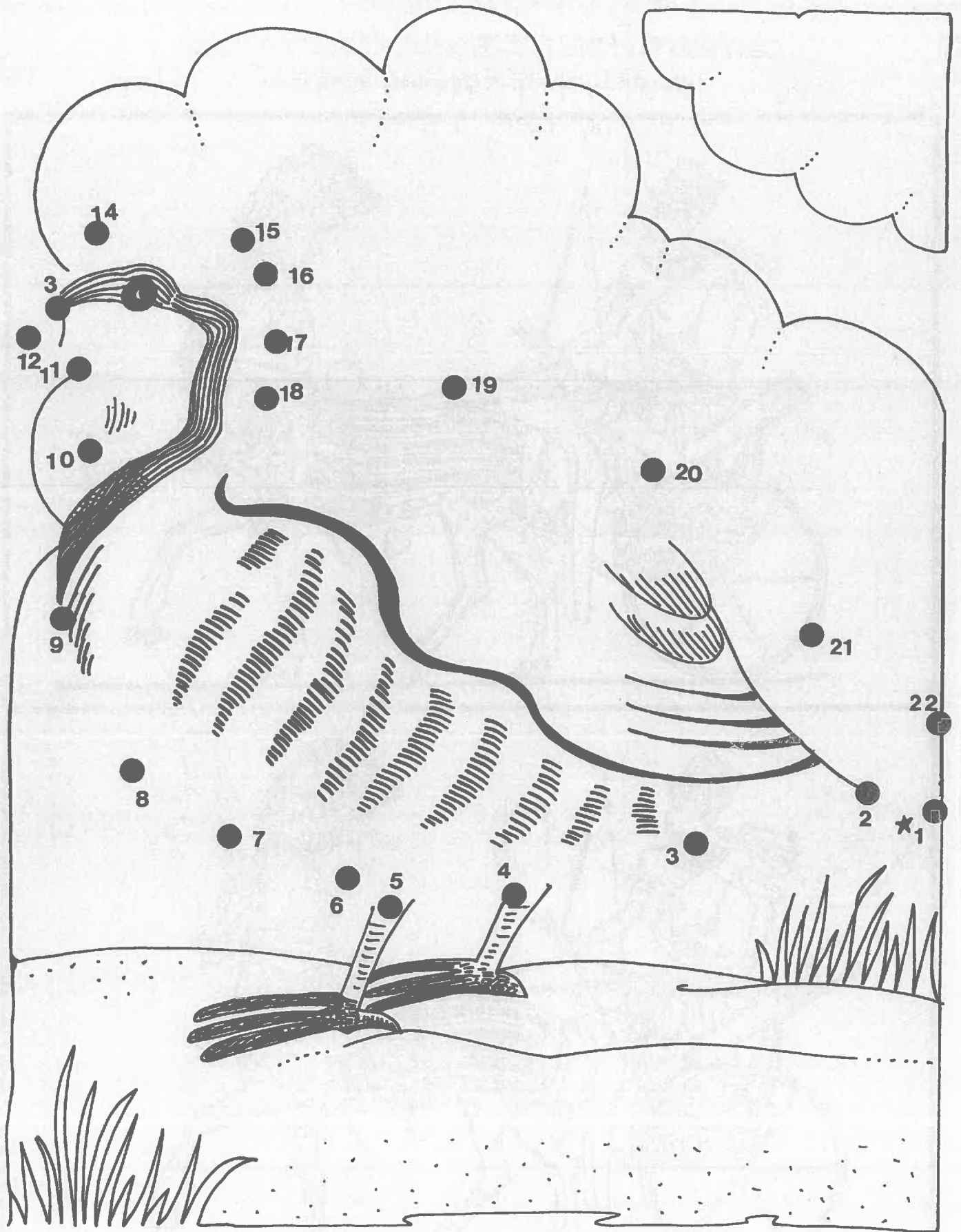
Were these people trusting God? What did they expect Moses to do? What is manna?

To play this game you need a die, six animal stickers, scissors, and cardboard. To make the counters, place the six animal stickers on cardboard and cut around them.

14 In the desert there is very little food and the Israelites are hungry. Go back three spaces.

5 Pharaoh changes his mind and sends his soldiers after the Israelites. Go back two spaces.

12 When the soldiers follow, God makes the water flow back and the soldiers drown. Go ahead one space.

God sends bread from the sky. Go ahead four spaces.

How to play

- Up to six people can play.
- Place your counters on Start.
- The person to throw the highest number starts.
- Then take turns throwing the die and move the number of spaces shown. Beware of the setbacks!
- Throw the exact number to finish the game.
