PUERTO RICO

Some Facts:

- Hurricane Maria caused about \$80 billion in damage.
- 45,000 homes are still waiting for government aid to fix roofs.
- 8,000 small businesses, 10 percent of the total, remain closed in the wake of Maria.
- The median FEMA grant made to homeowners after Maria was \$1,800, compared with \$9,127 paid to those affected by Hurricane Harvey in Texas according to *The New York Times*. Many who applied for aid were denied often because they were unable to prove home ownership.

Puerto Rico is still suffering from the effects of Hurricane Maria that struck the island in September 2017. In many ways they have been forgotten.
