

Here are three types of poems that anyone can write. Just pick a theme and follow the format!

HAIKU

A haiku is a Japanese form of poetry that consists of three lines, with the first line containing five syllables, the second line containing seven syllables, and the third line containing five syllables. Here's an example:

JESUS
Human and divine,
offers love and forgiveness;
Jesus is our friend.

FALL
Brightly colored leaves,
wind blowing leaves off the trees;
the days get shorter.

ACROSTIC

An acrostic poem is one in which the first letter in each line spells out a word.

Joyful servant
Everlasting life
Spiritual leader
Unconditional love
Son of God

Falling leaves
Amazing colors
Lessening daylight
Lowering temperatures

CINQUAIN

A cinquain poem is a verse of five lines with the first line containing two syllables, the second line containing four syllables, the third line containing six syllables, the fourth line containing eight syllables, and the fifth line containing two syllables.

Jesus
loves all people,
was born in a manger,
healed the sick, befriended sinners:
God's Son.

Autumn:
bright leaves falling,
Halloween, trick-or-treat.
Temperatures fall, days get shorter.
It's fall.
