

This week's lesson is about Joshua and the Spies. Read the Bible story page 128-131 in The Beginner's Bible.

After Moses died, Joshua became the leader of the Israelites. God led them to the promised land. Joshua sent the spies into the the city of Jericho that was protected by high walls to find out what the land was like. The king of Jericho sent his soldiers to capture the spies but a kind woman Rahab hid them on her roof. The spies thanked Rahab and promised to save her and her family when they returned.

God promised to protect the spies on their mission and led them safely out of Jericho.

Activities:

Play a game of "I spy" outside with your children. "I spy something blue" "I spy something yellow" etc.

Play hide and go seek with the children reenacting being the "spies" hiding.

Take a walk or hike in a new neighborhood or area that you haven't been to discover what the land is like just as Joshua and the spies did.
