Dear Students,

The Harold G. Williams Jr. Scholarship Fund was established in order to honor our Pastor Emeritus, Harold G. Williams, and to provide a source of funds, which would be available for a scholarship to members of our congregation who are presently, or will be in the fall, full time students enrolled in a college, trade school or graduate program. Special consideration may be given to a student in seminary or a student involved in mission work.

This year two recipients will be awarded \$500 each on Graduation Sunday, June 11, 2017 during the 9:00AM service. The recipient of the scholarship will be notified by Friday June 9 with the hope that they will be available to accept the award in person. If the recipient is unable to attend, arrangements must be made to have another family member/friend receive the award on their behalf.

No academic or financial need restrictions are placed on this scholarship. Each applicant will be considered according to his or her own merit, with confidentiality and discretion by the Deacon Scholarship Committee. However, a demonstrated commitment to Bedford Presbyterian Church and serving others is a subjective criterion. Past scholarship recipients may reapply as long as they meet the criteria.
